The undersigned makes the following declarations subject to the penalty of perjury and says: That I am a peace officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Clark County, Nevada, being so employed for a period of approximately 1 year(s).

That I learned the following facts and circumstances which lead me to believe that the above named subject committed or was committing the offenses above at the location of 3570 LAS VEGAS BLVD S LAS VEGAS NEVADA 89109 LAS VEGAS NEVADA 89109 and that the offense(s) occurred at approximately 05:08 hours on the 24th day of September, 2021.

Details for Probable Cause:

****BWC Available***

On September 24th, 2021 at approximately 0508 hours I, Officer R. Boschetti P#18363, Officer C. Lang P#17660, and Officer K. Johnson P#18023 while operating as marked patrol units 1M38, 1M12, and 1M35 were dispatched to the Caesars Palace located at 3570 South Las Vegas Blvd LV, NV 89109 in reference to a domestic disturbance that occurred in room #6716. Details of the call stated that a battery occurred between a white female adult as she was bleeding from her nose/ mouth and a black male adult who is a professional MMA fighter.

Upon arrival I contacted Caesars Palace security who stated the suspected black male adult involved had just left property wearing a blue long sleeve shirt and jeans and was walking with two Hispanic or white male adults. Officer Lang broadcasted over the radio the suspect description and as they immediately captured the black male adult walking northbound on the boulevard on fusion watch cameras. The black male adult was then detained by Officer L. Northcut P#17559 in the crosswalk of the Mirage. The black male adult was verbally identified as Jones, Jonathan DOB PII 1987. As Jones was being detained he became irate and smashed his head onto the front hood of the LVMPD patrol vehicle #18089 leaving a medium size dent as well as chipping of some of the paint on the vehicle. Estimated cost of the damage left on the vehicle is around Rescue 212 and AMR 101 arrived on scene to check out Jones.

I later made contact with the white female adult in Caesars security officer who was verbally identified as Moses, Jessie DOB PII 1987. Moses stated that she is engaged to Jones and have been together for seventeen years and have three children together. When asked if they had been arguing at all during the night she stated, "No". Moses stated that they were together up till around 2230 hours on 9/23/2021 and that when Jones went out with his friends as Moses stayed in her room. When I asked Moses what happened she said, "she was sleeping and Jones came back was not very happy". When asked if anything got physical Moses said, "Umm not to physical but a little bit yeah". When asked how it got

physical Moses said, " he touched the back of my head and pulled my hair a little bit but he did not hit me or anything". When asked why Jones pulled her hair Moses said because , "I was trying to leave the room". I observed blood all over Moses clothing and a bump with dried up blood on the lower part of her lip as if she was in a physical altercation. Moses was unaware of anything happening to her lip and said, "I know they are really dry". . Around 0500 hours today 9/24/2021 Jones came back to the room and was intoxicated and was acting aggressive

A voluntary statement was obtained by Caesars security guard Villa, Cassandra which stated at 0435 hours Moses arrived at the security booth asking to get a key to her room. Villa then explained that she would have to go to the front desk to get another key but then realized she had blood on her lip and her clothing and asked if Moses was okay and she immediately began to tear up. Villa then asked if she felt scared to go back to the room and she explained that she was scared to go back to the room. Moses then advised that she did not feel safe going back to the room so she was taken to the security officer with her children. Villa then stated that the youngest child of Moses made a comment saying, "Can you call the cops".

After Jones was detained his wrestling coach Martinez, Israel explained to Officer Northcut that he received a call from Jones after the incident to come meet up with him at Ceasars.

Due to the above facts and circumstances that Jones did willfully and unlawfully use force and violence upon the person of another with whom he shares a domestic relationship, by grabbing Moses by her hair as she was attempting to leave the room to go along with the inconsistency of the bump on Moses bottom lip with blood splattered on her clothing leaving me with reason to believe there was a battery and probable cause for Jones to be in violation of Nrs 200.485.1a Domestic Battery. Jones also damage a patrol vehicle by slamming his head on the front hood of the patrol vehicle causing it to leave a medium size dent and a paint being chipped of, Jones was also in violation of Nrs 206.310 Destroy/Injure Pub Comm/Trans/Pol/Fire Protect.

Jones was placed under arrest and transported to CCDC and booked accordingly.

Pd was notified and responded to the scene and the following is a synopsis of there investigation On 9/24/2021 I, Detective T. Byrd P#13958, responded to a Domestic Disturbance at Caesars Palace Hotel. Details of the call stated Patrol Officers had the suspect, Jonathan Jones DOE PII 1987, in custody. The victim, Jessie Moses DOB PII 1987, was in the security room of the hotel with Security Officers.

I, along with Det. Mason P#15386 and Sgt. Baker P#6623, responded to conduct an interview with Jessie. Jessie did not want the interview to be recorded and did not want to fill out a voluntary statement. She stated she was in her bed of the hotel room when Jonathan returned after being out drinking with his friends. She said he was aggressive but not violent with her. She would not go into detail about the aggressive behavior but said she did not feel safe in the room with him. She grabbed her three daughters and left the room. Prior to getting her daughters, Jonathan grabbed her by the back of her hair and pulled her back towards the room. She said she didn't feel like he was keeping her from leaving but said he didn't want her to leave. She then got away from him, grabbed the kids and left the room. She went to the security desk to get another room because she did not want to be around Jonathan. She had dried blood around her lips, chin, and all over her sweatshirt. There was even blood on the rear elbow portions of her sweatshirt. She also had a swollen lower lip, red mark to upper right cheek and was visibly upset and seemed scared to even talk about Jonathan. She would not allow Detectives to take photos of her injuries but did allow us to view the hotel room. She gave verbal consent to enter the room. Detectives, along with a uniformed patrol officer with body camera, entered room 6716. As we entered the room Jessie's cell phone was face down near the stairs. She took us to the bedroom where she said the altercation took place. There was blood on the bed sheets, as well as shoes strewn about. There were two fresh tissues on the floor. The rest of the room appeared to be well kept with clothing and other items packed away and not out of place. As Detectives were leaving, Jessie asked "so how long do I have until he is out?". She still seemed very scared as to the release of Jonathan from jail. She was provided a Domestic Violence blue card with information on obtaining a protection order which she said she did not want at this time.

Wherefore, Declarant prays that a finding be made by a magistrate that probable cause exists to hold said person for preliminary hearing (if charges are a felony or gross misdemeanor) or for trial (if charges are misdemeanor).

On 9/24/2020 I, along with Det. Mason, conducted a recorded interview with Jonathan at Convention Center Area Command. I read Jonathan his rights per Miranda at 7:47 AM which he responded "yes sir" indicating he was willing to speak with Detectives. Prior to even reading Jonathan his rights, he was extremely agitated with LVMPD and said he will have a huge lawsuit with the department for putting him in handcuffs on the biggest night of his life. After reading him his rights, he immediately broke down into tears and started to tell us about his night. His emotions were all over the place, going from extremely agitated with us, to talking calmly, to crying. He went on to tell us he and his "wife" (Jessie) were going through a lot recently **PRVCY** [REDACTED] The two have been arguing about the tension between them, but he never got physical. He said he couldn't remember the last time he saw his wife other than kissing her and his kids by at the loading dock of the hotel. He said later he remembered going back up to the room and getting \$10,000 and telling Jessie he was going to the strip club. She had no problem with that, however an argument started over the relationship. He said he told her to "fuck off" without actually telling her that. He said he couldn't remember what happened when he left. He said he never touched her, never pulled her hair, never saw her with a bloody nose but also did not remember walking out of the hotel. He said he was agitated when the police took him into custody for no reason and head butted the patrol vehicle. He was very agitated when asked about the damage he did to the patrol car.

After the interview I notified him we would be getting him to jail for the Domestic Violence as well as the damage to the patrol vehicle. He thanked me and started joking about the arrest. He stated jokingly that he would like to take us all on and see what we could do. While placing him into handcuffs, he jokingly feinted that he was going to escape the handcuffs and fight the officers. When I told he we are not playing and that he would be tased if he did it again, he apologized and complied with being put into handcuffs. Again, this shows the emotional roller coaster Jonathan displayed during the interview and arrest. He was then transported to CCDC and booked accordingly.

Sheriff*, 126 Nev. 211, 218, 234 P.3d 922, 927 (2010), the Nevada Supreme Court recognized that an individual's privacy must be balanced with the public's general right to open government, "especially because private and personal information may be recorded in government files"). Later, in *Clark County Sch. Dist. v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, --- Nev. ---, 429 P.3d 313, 319-20 (2018), the Court adopted a balancing test in which the burden shifts to the requester of a record if the public agency demonstrates a "nontrivial personal privacy interest" including "intrusion[s] into a person's reasonable expectation of privacy, seclusion, or solitude." Privacy interests include information that may cause "embarrassment, shame, stigma, [or] harassment" or "endangerment, or similar harm." *Las Vegas Metro. Police Dep't v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, 136 Nev. Ad. Op 86, --- P.3d -- (2020). Medical information, personnel files, details about sexual orientation, and other information about a person's life give rise to privacy interests. *Clark County Office of the Coroner/Medical Examiner v. Las Vegas Review-Journal*, 136 Nev. Adv. Op. 5, --- P.3d -- (2020).
